## Expanded Dental Services for the Intellectual and Developmental Disabilities (ID) Waiver An ASD and Nevada Medicaid Services Initiative

### Expanded Services

Individuals on the ID waiver are served through the State of Nevada Aging and Disability Services Division (ADSD) and will be receiving information about their benefits through their Service Coordinator. The scope and nature of this service differs from State Plan Dental Service for Adults, which only offers emergency extractions, palliative care, and removable prosthesis with prior authorization. Expanded dental services include but are not limited to:

- **Restoration:** amalgam filling, resin-based composite filling, prefabricated stainless steel crown and resin-crown, core buildup, etc.
- **Preventative care:** regular check-ups, cleaning, fluoride treatments, x-rays, fillings, periodontal maintenance, periodontal scaling and root planning and root canal therapy.



Services require a treatment plan in order for care to be paid for to be covered.



Dentists and oral health care specialists, we need you! We have a unique opportunity to improve access to dental care for adults with intellectual and developmental disabilities in our communities. The oral health outcomes for this population are poor, and there is a critical need for care, as well as an opportunity supported by the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) to provide a full range of services.

Under the Expanded Services Waiver, **effective February 1 2023**, individuals ages 21 and older on the Intellectual and Developmental Disabilities (ID) Waiver are now eligible for temporary expanded dental benefits that can literally be life changing and preserve their health and wellness.
